## About Classic Car Adventures

Classic Car Adventures (CCA) is a collective of classic car enthusiasts with a central focus on the joy of driving. There are no membership fees, no monthly meetings. All you need is a love of cars, and a willingness to get together and drive them. Over the course of the motoring season we run seven events, stretching from the Pacific Northwest all the way to the East Coast.

Our events are for those who enjoy spirited driving on some of the most challenging and beautiful roads in the world. Entrants are welcome regardless of marque or model, and the resulting mix of cars and people is a fresh departure from

standard club gatherings. Concourse cars are more than welcome, but we also encourage those less-than-mint, hard-driven, budget classics to take part. The common denominator is that the participants all love the art of driving and believe their 'old' car is meant to be driven on the open road.



## Vehicle Eligibility

Classic Car Adventures events are open to sport, touring and classic cars from 1979 and earlier. Sorry, no motorcycles...and usually no trucks.

Vehicles must meet legal road-worthiness standards, and generally be ready for a long weekend of driving through mountains and winding roads. Occasionally we allow post-1979 vehicles, and tastefully modified trucks into our events...but the organizers evaluate these on a case-by-case basis.

Vehicles may also be accepted based on the CCA "Delorean Rule". If you own a Delorean DMC-12, and wish to enter the event, your vehicle will be accepted without prejudice...though you are required to allow the organizers a chance to drive it. The "Delorean Rule" has been used to successfully enter a variety of ineligible vehicles in the past, though spaces for non-compliant vehicles are limited.





## About The Hagerty Silver Summit

### Overview

The Hagerty Silver Summit is a budget-minded driving adventure through Colorado for pre-1979 touring and sports cars. This unscored, non-competitive event takes place entirely within the state of Colorado and consists of approximately 750 miles of driving over three days. The event seeks out the best mountain roads to drive and features 100% paved roads.



The primary objective of the Silver Summit is adventurous motoring on Colorado's hidden backcountry highways...harking back to a time where the driver's senses were the 'warning lights', and they knew where to locate the engine!! While adventure and hidden highways remains our top priority, we ensure a sweep-vehicle is following each event so that motorists can reach a town with telephone services should a problem arise.

### Tour, Race or Rally?

CCA events are a unique, new form of adventure motoring, and don't really qualify as a race, tour or rally. Each of our events are non-competitive with no timing. This is not a race, and guests are expected to drive responsibly on open roads.

Conversly, it's not a 'tour' in the traditional sense. We won't be leading the group and requiring that you drive bumper to bumper with the cars around you. Unlike many car rallies, we aren't out to trick you. The route instructions are clear and easy to follow, and don't require any calculations or rally knowledge.



Each CCA event includes an easy to follow routebook, but you're free to follow the day's route at your own pace. Whether carving up canyons with classics from all eras, or stopping for photos and sight-seeing, you're sure to enjoy our style of adventuring.

## The Route

In the spirit of all our Classic Car Adventures, the route details for each Silver Summit will be kept secret, revealed to the entrants only upon picking up their routebooks the morning of the event. Our “secret routes” help to add to the sense of adventure during the event, and many guests are surprised to discover hidden gems inside their own home state.

For 2015, the Hagerty Silver Summit will start in Lakewood CO (Denver), and finish in Colorado Springs.

## Supplemental Regulations and Entry Fees

Supplemental regulations which explain all the details of the event will be posted on the CCA website December 15th, 2014. The Entry forms for the Hagerty Silver Summit Adventure will be posted on January 16th, 2015.

While final entry fees will be confirmed with the release of entry forms, based on our experience with previous events, we estimate the entry fee for the Hagerty Silver Summit Adventure to be \$650 USD per car.

A paid entry to the Silver Summit is based on one car, shared with two people (Driver and Co-Driver). The entry includes two nights hotel, dinner each night for both guests, routebook, name tags, number decals for the vehicle, and a gift bag of branded give-aways.
